

## Kane County Burning Regulations

DEFINITIONS: "LANDSCAPE WASTE" MEANS ALL ACCUMULATIONS OF GRASS OR SHRUBBERY CUTTINGS, LEAVES, FLOWERS, AND WEEDS. "BRUSH" MEANS TREE TRUNKS, LIMBS, BRANCHES, AND TWIGS.

Surning of dry landscape waste and/or brush is currently permitted, subject to the Standard Restrictions The burning of any materials besides "Landscape Waste and Brush" is prohibited and punishable.

## STANDARD RESTRICTIONS (These apply to all zip codes)

- Only on the property upon which the landscape waste or brush was generated
- Only on sunny days from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Not when wind exceeds 10mph
- Not within 20 feet of any building, structure, or property line
- Not during announced inversion conditions or ozone alerts
- Any burning must be supervised until the fire is extinguished; a fire extinguisher; garden hose or water source must be available at the burning site

## EXEMPTIONS

- 1. Any property zoned and used for agricultural purposes. Burning of garbage and/or other hazardous materials or chemicals is prohibited regardless of exemptions. (These properties fall under the IL State Laws)
- 2. Burning for the purpose of prairie restoration or firefighter training
- 3. Burning of brush in fire places and self-contained outdoor wood burning devices
- 4. Burning of brush for recreational fires, but the fire cannot be larger than 3'x3'x3'
- 5. Ceremonial fires for a scheduled public or private event. Notice must be given to the local fire department, and a permit must be applied for through the Kane County Health Department (630) 444-3040. The fee is \$25.00.

## PENALTIES A FINE UP TO \$500 SHALL PUNISH ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION.
