Call to Order The public hearing on the Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Fox River & Countryside Fire Rescue District for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2022, was called to order at 5:46 PM, on Monday, July 25, 2022, in the Meeting Room at Station 1, located at 34W500 Carl Lee Rd., St. Charles, IL 60174 by President LeBlanc
 - a. Roll Call:

 - b. Pledge of Allegiance: President LeBlanc led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance
- 2. Public Comment President LeBlanc asked for public comment on the Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance 2022-02. A resident asked what circumstances are attributing to the increase in ambulance calls.
- 3. Trustee Wegman asked Brad O'Sullivan questions regarding the bond funds and redistribution of all funds in the proposed budget. Brad and Trustee Parthun responded, and a discussion ensued. Anthony Miceli from Speer Financial is still determining the total debt amount to be retired and is confirming if leases can be retired early. James Howard with Gov Accounting confirmed via cell phone specifics on redistribution.
